Miami County Economic Development Authority (MCEDA) is preparing a Joint Land Use Study to evaluate and provide recommendations related to land use compatibility in the vicinity of Grissom Air Reserve Base.

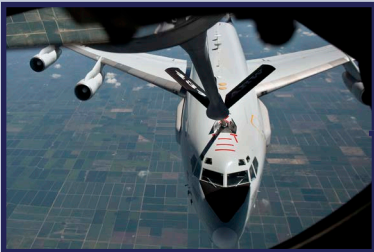
The Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) is a community-driven, cooperative planning process involving MCEDA, Grissom Air Reserve Base, Grissom Aeroplex, surrounding local governments, and other stakeholders in the community. It will be directed by an appointed Policy Committee and a Technical Working Group and completed by a consulting team hired by MCEDA.

The primary goal of the Study is to promote compatibility between community development and the Air Reserve Command's operations at Grissom, while minimizing the negative impacts of those operations on the adjacent communities.

The kick-off meeting will include a brief presentation by the JLUS consulting team, a live-polling survey to receive initial public feedback, and an opportunity to discuss and pose questions to the JLUS consulting team and MCEDA staff.
