

Grissom Air Reserve Base Joint Land Use Study

Miami County Economic Development Authority (MCEDA) is finalizing a Joint Land Use Study that evaluates and provides recommendations related to land use compatibility in the vicinity of Grissom Air Reserve Base. The Grissom Air Reserve Base (ARB) Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) was a cooperative planning effort involving MCEDA, Grissom ARB, Grissom Aeroplex, surrounding local governments, and other stakeholders in the community.

The primary goal of the JLUS is to promote compatibility between community development and the Air Reserve Command's operations at Grissom, while minimizing the negative impacts of those operations on the adjacent communities.

A long history of collaboration between Grissom ARB and the surrounding community has resulted in few land use incompatibilities. To preserve this, a 'tool box' of Recommendations, or Conflict Resolution Strategies were developed. The final public meeting will include a presentation of the final JLUS report and Strategies, as well as an opportunity to discuss and pose questions to the JLUS consulting team and MCEDA staff.
